Please choose one of the prompts listed below and respond in your reflection essay. Your response must be a minimum of one page, double spaced, typed in Times New Roman font, size 12. **Remember to answer each part of the prompt.**

Personal Growth:

Compare how you felt at the beginning of this experience to your feelings at the end. What made you feel that way at first, and what made your feelings change? What did this teach you about yourself?

Learning about a Group of People:

Describe the people you met during this experience and how their lives are similar/different from yours. Discuss what you learned about these people and how your opinion of the people changed from when you started.

Learning the Problem, Developing a Solution:

Discuss the problems you saw during this experience, and explain what other needs you think the people have. How could society better deal with the problem? What larger scale projects could be done?
